MEETING PROCEDURES

1. The President shall preside over the meeting, in accordance with section 5.30(1) of the Local Government Act 1995.
2. An Elector has a right to one vote, but does not have to vote.
3. Only Electors may speak with the approval of the President.
4. Notice of Motions and questions should be lodged in writing with the Shire of Three Springs at least two working days before the meeting. This will ensure matters are appropriately dealt with at the meeting.
5. When addressing the meeting, a person, unless unable to do so, shall:
 - a) Stand and speak to the meeting
 - b) State their name and address for recording in the Minutes.
 - c) Address the meeting through the President.
6. The President will determine questions relating to order and procedure that are not listed above.
7. An Elector may move a Motion at the meeting which will only be considered if it has a Secunder.
8. Motions carried at this meeting are not binding on the Council, although Motions carried are presented at the next Ordinary Council Meeting for noting or for consideration.
9. Voting is determined by a show of hands or other form of open voting determined by the President.
10. A simple majority carries the vote.
11. Minutes of this meeting will be available for inspection by members of the public.
12. To ensure the Electors Meeting remains respectful and productive, participants are reminded that all comments and discussions must be conducted in a manner that upholds the dignity and professionalism of the meeting. Publicly making slanderous or defamatory comments about staff, their work practices, or standards—whether directly or implied—will not be tolerated. Such comments undermine the principles of fairness and respect, as staff members are not present to provide context or defend themselves. Attendees are encouraged to submit any concerns in writing prior to the meeting, allowing the organization to address matters factually and appropriately. These measures ensure the meeting remains focused on constructive dialogue and community outcomes.
