Good Morning Three Springs

Three Springs Magistrate court was back to being held locally and took place on Wednesday 22nd July 2020 with the following results;

A 48 year old female from Morawa was convicted for possessing cannabis, she was fined \$500 suspended for 9 months and ordered to pay \$225.90 in court costs.

A 28 year old female from Carnamah was convicted possessing cannabis and drug paraphernalia, she was fined \$1000 and ordered to pay \$225.90 in court costs.

A 19 year old female from Morawa was convicted of driving without a licence and driving an unlicensed vehicle, she was fined \$450 and ordered to pay \$225.90 in court costs.

A 52 year old male from Morawa was convicted aggravated burglary, he sentenced to a 9 month intensive supervision order and ordered to pay \$225.90 in court costs.

A 40 year old male from Watheroo was convicted driving without a licence and having possession of unlicensed ammunition, he was fined \$550 and ordered to pay \$225.90 in court costs.

A 38 year old male from Geraldton was convicted driving without a licence, he was fined \$300 and ordered to pay \$225.90 in court costs.

A 39 year old male from Three Springs was convicted of causing damage, he was fined \$850 and ordered to pay \$838.20 in compensation.

A 27 year old female from Morawa was convicted of possessing cannabis, she was fined \$250 and ordered to pay \$225.90 in court costs.

We have also received a few reports of cyber scamming and personal online accounts being spammed. With this it is important to regularly update your online security and make sure you have no personal details easily accessible to other online users. Should you receive any suspicious emails, please report them to SCAMwatch.gov.au or come and speak to us at the station for any assistance.

On a more positive note it has been great to see so many young kids around town on push bikes and scooters whilst maintaining road safety. We were recently donated 6 more push bikes which were collected by Darryl Dalgetty who has been fixing up the bikes and putting them to good use for local residents. Thank you for your hard work Darryl.

Dark Sky Sensitive Lights!

WA has a world-class dark night sky. The latest research shows that now, there are over 2 billion people around the world who cannot see the Milky Way like we can in country WA.

So it's a very important natural asset for us to keep safe for future generations and visitors.

You'll be pleased to know that there are now new dark sky sensitive lights available for purchase in Australia! These range from streetlights to bollard lighting and pathway lights.

We're very lucky in Australia to have an organisation dedicated to helping reduce light pollution. The Australasian Dark Sky Alliance (ADSA) has recently created a system to give streetlights and other outdoor lights the tick of approval. You can see the ADSA Approved lights on their website www.australasiandarkskyalliance.org/certifiedluminaires.



Stargazing Tip – The Milky Way Galaxy

Winter is a great time to see the beautiful band of the Milky Way running right across the night sky. When you look towards the constellation of Sagittarius, you're looking to the very heart of the Milky Way Galaxy. We're lucky to see it much better here than in the Northern Hemisphere, especially under dark country skies.

The Milky Way was always thought to be about 100,000 light years across. Recent data suggests there is a vast disk of gas beyond, which is almost 2 million light-years across.

And what is a light-year? Glad you asked! It is the distance light travels in one year, travelling at 300,000 kms/sec. This equals a distance of 9.5 trillion kms. So, space is a really big place!

Travel: to cancel or not to cancel?

If you're a Western Australian who loves to travel, then odds are high you've had a trip cancelled or postponed due to the COVID-19 coronavirus pandemic.

Hopefully your refund or remedy was sorted quickly, but if not, you're certainly not alone. Complaints to Consumer Protection were five times higher in the period from March 1 2020 until now, compared with the same period last year.

Of the 625 travel-related complaints received, more than half were from consumers seeking refunds that were either denied or were offered credit notes instead.

With travel emerging as one of the biggest consumer issues to arise from the pandemic, regulators across Australia have been working on creating guidance for how the travel industry should handle such cancellations.

Those guidelines have now been released and suggest that in circumstances where a travel service has not yet been cancelled – but travel restrictions mean it may be cancelled in the future – travel operators should advise on the remedies available depending on who cancels the booking.

A consumer cancelling too early could be viewed as a change of mind, so it's very important to check the terms and conditions before deciding whether to cancel yourself or wait until there is greater certainty.

Your best option could be to wait until the travel provider makes a decision, as this may provide a broader range of options.

It is always worthwhile contacting your travel provider to find out what options you have for deferring your trip to a later date. In particular, check what flexibility may exist around using international travel credits for a domestic travel booking.

When it comes to booking future travel, the international travel bans and interstate border restrictions mean this can be a risky prospect.

A safer option currently is intra-state travel, however we would advise booking something within WA as close to the date of travel as possible, given the pandemic continues to present ongoing and evolving challenges.

Sea container investments not so water-tight

If you've seen an advert promising big returns on an investment in shipping containers, then our advice is to consider whether it may be a scam or Ponzi scheme.

WA ScamNet is aware of \$800,000 of losses in Western Australia so far to a venture called Pacific Tycoon, which advertises investments in shipping containers and promises returns of up to 20 per cent when they lease it out on your behalf.

The scheme is predicted to be successful because cargo shipment companies regularly have urgent requirements for extra containers and will pay premium prices.

While victims claim they initially do receive dividends, this slowly reduces significantly. Pacific Tycoon continues to encourage further investment before eventually stopping all communication.

Despite us issuing an earlier warning about this venture, victims are still reporting large losses and are unable to contact the company nor take legal action to recover the funds.

All indications point to Pacific Tycoon being a Ponzi scheme – a form of fraud involving a non-existent business that continues before initial investors are given dividends using the start-up money paid by those who join the bogus scheme later on.

When considering all investment 'opportunities', ask yourself:

Is the business registered with the Australian Securities Investment Commissioner (ASIC)?

How long has the company been around?

Have you spoken to a financial adviser about the proposal?

Can you speak to clients who have made money using this method?

If you were to lose money investing in this scheme, can you afford that?

Be aware that if an investment scheme turns out to be a web-based fraud by overseas criminals, authorities in Australia may not have the resources, appropriate international powers or law enforcement connections to find those responsible or trace your money.
